# BELIZE

Remar commenced their labour in this country in 1996, with a group of missionaries in the city of Belize. Rapidly we opened our first centre for men, to this day, we have installed four houses for men, a building for families, an office for admission and information for people who need help, various stores and a soup kitchen which assists more than 150 people daily. We also offer a breakfast program every morning for 200 children without resources, to improve nutrition and education. Agreements have been signed with agencies of the government, participating in the development in policies and strategies anti-drugs, being part of an active cooperation on the solution of social scourge, which affects this country. Remar comprehensively serves more than 400 people.

## REHABILITATION CENTERS



Remar's rehab centres consists of three phases, which is the First Phase (Detoxification and physical recovery), Second Phase (Rehabilitation) and a Third Phase (Reinsertion). Our first phase is located in Bullet Tree Falls in Cayo District, which is a farm of approximately 30 acres. Our second phase is located in the city in this phase they are encouraged to renew contact with their relatives.



## FEEDING THE POOR ►

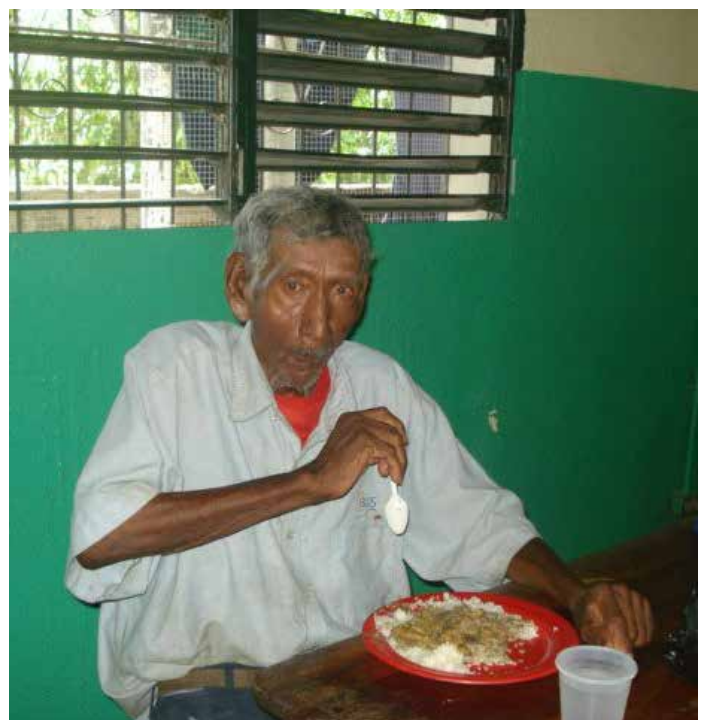


Children are one of the most vulnerable sectors of the population to the social and economical problems that we particularly find in the countries where REMAR is working. Without fear and with much love in our hearts we reach to the children in the most poor areas in Belize, such as those in the streets known as The Jungle (Kelly St., York St., Victoria St. and on Raccoon Extension and all the dirt roads behind the cemetery) sharing breakfast to the children which sometimes it is their only meal, at present we cater to about 200 children in the week.

## SOUP KITCHEN



Remar can't remain passive to the hunger situation that exists in our country characterized by extreme poverty and for that reason has established a social lunchroom where lunch is served to many people thus favouring to those who are the less fortunate in society, children and elderly being the children the ones that demand special attention. The work done at this kitchen help about 75 people a day, Monday through Friday.



## ANGELS OF THE NIGHT



Each week we continue with the social work on the streets and the parks of our city offering something to eat, talking face to face to the persons living in the streets and at the same time inviting them to join our program. In the same way we offer food and shelter for indefinite time to those joining our program.
